Implementation services

Odoo offers two types of implementation services, depending on the version selected. For Odoo Online, implementations are typically managed directly by Odoo's internal consultants, following a standardized, remote delivery model. For Odoo Enterprise (on-premise or Odoo.sh), implementations are usually carried out by a network of certified local partners. Odoo also provides packaged implementation offers for standard projects, with predefined pricing between \$2,500 and \$5,500. More complex or tailored deployments are priced on a case-by-case basis, managed by either Odoo or its partners depending on the project type and customer preference.

SoftOne relies exclusively on certified local partners for all implementation services. These partners handle deployment, configuration, data migration, training, and ongoing support. Implementation costs for SoftOne are calculated case-by-case, based on project size, the number of modules involved, and specific customization needs. Unlike Odoo, SoftOne does not offer packaged implementation pricing, which can make project cost estimations less predictable, especially for smaller businesses.

Odoo provides both direct and partner-led implementations, with the option of packaged offers for standard projects and case-by-case pricing for complex ones. Its global network of certified partners ensures broad availability and expertise.
