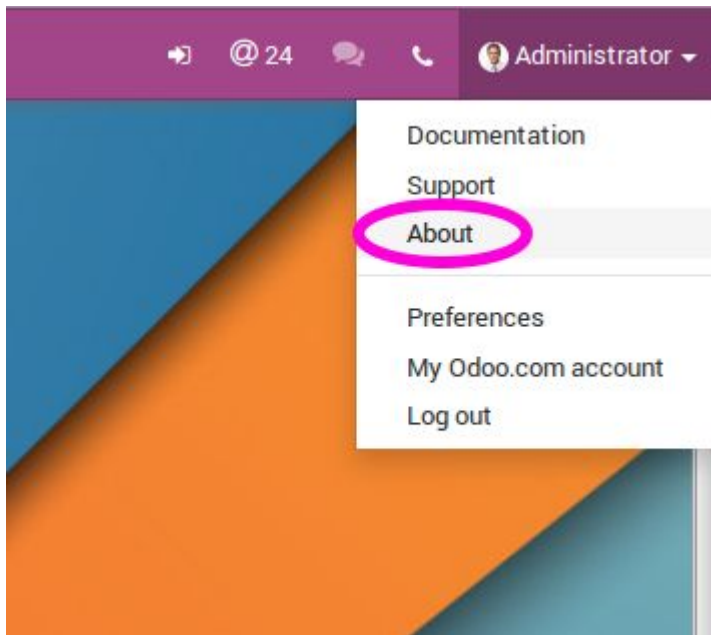

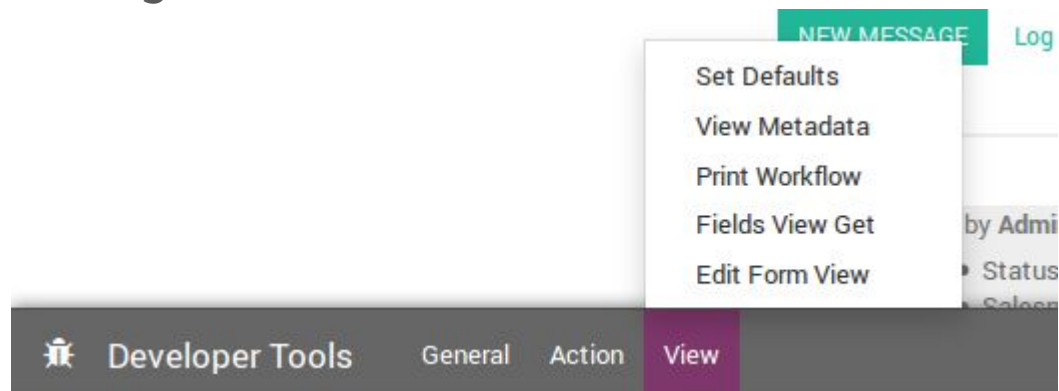

2 modes

- Developer mode

`http://<server_url>/web?debug#home`

- Developer mode (with assets)

`http://<server_url>/web?debug=assets#home`



Debug tools

Standard tools

- Javascript
 - Activate Developer mode (with assets)
 - Tools of the browser (F12 key)
- Python
 - pdb, ipdb, pudb...
 - Requires access to server console

QWeb tools

- Attribute 't-debug' in template:

```
<span t-debug="pdb" t-if="line.discount">Discount</span>
```

- Launch server with option '--dev=all'
